No. 145 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING SECTIONS 58, 59, 60
AND 61 OF CHAPTER 1981-40, EFFECTIVE JULY 20, 1981,
ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES
OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN
CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS", RELATIVE
TO WATER SUPPLY BOARD.

Approved March 26, 1982

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Sections 58, 59, 60 and 61 of Chapter 1981-40 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, effective July 20, 1981, entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing the Classes of Positions, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the City Departments and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1981-12, effective March 23, 1981", are hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 58. The number of Employees in the Water Supply Board-Administration shall not exceed Nine (9). There shall be no more than:

- 1 Chief Engineer/General Manager, Water Supply Board
- 1 Attorney, Water

Sec. 59. The number of Employees in the Water Supply Board-Commercial shall not exceed thirty-one (31). There shall be no more than:

Sec. 60. The number of Employees in the Water Supply Board-Operations shall not exceed one hundred twenty-three (123). There shall be no more than:


