WHEREAS, the boiler tubes in the steam generating boilers Nos. 1 and 2 at the City of Providence incinerator are in such condition that they must be immediately replaced, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to immediately provide the money for the necessary work in order that the public health be preserved by the continued uninterrupted operation of the incinerator

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1143 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1957, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$36,161,545.40 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1958", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars to PUBLIC WORKS-GARBAGE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SECTION, ITEM 1.

SEC. 2. The said sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and the City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures to the Receipt Account.


SEC. 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars.





No. 300 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT CHAPTER 544, THE
ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RELATING TO
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

Approved June 6, 1958

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Sec. 22 and Paragraph 6 of Sec. 27 of Chapter 544 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Providence, as amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 22. Buildings and Uses Not Affected by Zoning.

Buildings housing religious bodies, churches, (except rescue or temporary revival missions), convents, hospitals (except hospitals or sanitariums for contagious, mental, drug or liquor addict cases and animal hospitals), libraries, homes for the aged, and museums, whenever such libraries, homes for the aged, or museums are operated on a non-profit basis, are exempt from the provisions of this Ordinance.

Land, buildings and structures owned or used on February 1, 1958 by educational institutions, as defined in Section 21, for their usual purposes and activities, including instructional and recreational uses, provision for exhibitions and athletic contests, and provisions for living quarters, dining rooms, restaurants, parking facilities, heating plants and other facilities incidental to the usual purposes and activities of such institutions, shall be deemed to be conforming uses in the zone in which the land is located; provided that no such use shall be permitted in any building hereafter erected by any such institution within thirty (30) feet of the boundary line of a lot owned by others in an R zone.

Other than aforesaid, no building or land shall hereafter be used and no building or part thereof shall be erected, moved or altered unless in conformity with the regulations of this ordinance.

"Sec. 27. Special exceptions.

6. Educational institution for its usual purposes and activities and facilities incidental thereto, in any location not permitted under the provisions of Section 22."

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 969-E - AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 544, THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, April 22, 1958.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

Section 1. Sec. 22 and Paragraph 6 of Sec. 27 of Chapter 544 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Providence, as amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 22. Buildings and Uses Not Affected by Zoning.

Buildings housing religious bodies, churches, (except rescue or temporary revival missions), convents, hospitals (except hospitals or sanitariums for contagious, mental, drug or liquor addict cases and animal hospitals), libraries, homes for the aged, and museums, whenever such libraries, homes for the aged, or museums are operated on a non-profit basis, are exempt from the provisions of this Ordinance.

Land, buildings and structures owned or used on February 1, 1958 by educational institutions, as defined in Section 21, for their usual purposes and activities, including instructional and recreational uses, provision for exhibitions and athletic contests, and provisions for living quarters, dining rooms, restaurants, parking facilities, heating plants and other facilities incidental to the usual purposes and activities of such institutions, shall be deemed to be conforming uses in the zone in which the land is located; provided that no such use shall be permitted in any building hereafter erected by any such institution within thirty (30) feet of the boundary line of a lot owned by others in an R zone.

Other than aforesaid, no building or land shall hereafter be used and no building or part thereof shall be erected, moved or altered unless in conformity with the regulations of this ordinance.

"Sec. 27. Special exceptions.

6. Educational institution for its usual purposes and activities and facilities incidental thereto, in any location not permitted under the provisions of Section 22."

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

No. 301 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 1040, Section 4, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, 1956, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR HOUSING" PERMITTING THE DIRECTOR OF DIVISION OF MINIMUM HOUSING STANDARDS TO APPLY FOR ZONING EXCEPTIONS.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Chapter 1040, Section 4, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, 1956, entitled "An Ordinance Providing Minimum Standards for Housing" is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

"Whenever a compliance order issued pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter requires an extension of a building into a required rear yard or side yard, or the execution of any compliance order will result in any violation of the Zoning Ordinance, the Director is authorized to apply to the Zoning Board of Review for a variance or exception. The Director shall file an application for and in behalf of the owner, and prepare the necessary radius plans and plot plans to be submitted to the Zoning Board of Review. For the purpose of preparing the necessary documents, the Director may use the facilities of any other department of the City. No filing fees shall be required of the Director.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

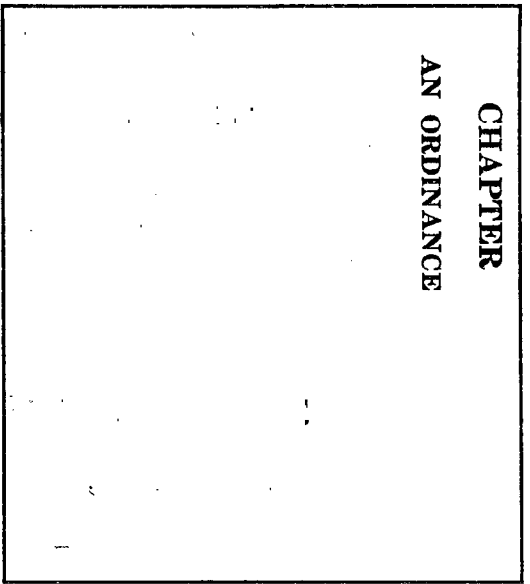
