

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42-64.3-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-64.3 entitled
 2 "Distressed Areas Economic Revitalization Act" is hereby amended to read as follows:
 3 **42-64.3-5. Criteria for enterprise zone designation.** -- (a) The zone shall consist of not
 4 more than five (5) contiguous United States census tracts or portions thereof as set forth in the
 5 most recent federal census, except that the council may add Block 101 of Census Tract 135 in the
 6 City of Cranston to any enterprise zone abutting that Block; provided, that the addition is
 7 approved by the city councils of Cranston and Providence; except that blocks 108, 110, and 111
 8 of Federal Census tract 8 of the Providence II Enterprise Zone shall not be eligible for any
 9 enterprise zone benefits, and as a replacement thereof, the Council may add blocks 318, 319, and
 10 307 of census tract 37 and block 104 of census tract 9, and blocks 105, 107 and 120 of census
 11 tract 12, to the Providence II Enterprise Zone, provided that such addition is approved by the city
 12 council of Providence; and, that portion of federal census tract 114.03 in the town of Cumberland
 13 which includes any portion of the Highland II Corporate Park as approved by the Cumberland
 14 town council and the Woonsocket city council; and, that portion of the federal census tract 173 in
 15 the city of Woonsocket which includes the Singleton Street Mill District as approved by the
 16 Woonsocket City Council, and federal census tract 114.02 in the town of Cumberland; ~~and~~
 17 except that the council may add blocks 103, 104, 119, and 131 of census tract 308 to the Mount
 18 Hope enterprise zone and those portions of federal census tracts 113.01 and 114.03 that

1 constitute the Ashton/Berkeley Mill Village area; except that the council may add Census Tract
2 180 in the city of Woonsocket to the Woonsocket/Cumberland Enterprise Zone as approved by
3 the Woonsocket city council; ~~and~~ except that the council may add the site of former Narragansett
4 Brewery in Cranston; and except that the council may add the following streets to the
5 “Providence II” Enterprise Zone designation: Hartford Avenue -- consisting of census tract 19
6 (Olneyville) and census tract 18 (Hartford Avenue, Hartford Section), Plainfield Street -- that
7 portion which runs through census tracts 16 (Silver Lake) and 19 (ending at Johnson Avenue),
8 and Pocasset Avenue -- census tracts 16 and 17.

9 (b) The council shall promulgate any additional criteria for the designation of an
10 enterprise zone that the council deems appropriate. Additional criteria shall include but not be
11 limited to:

- 12 (1) The poverty level within the enterprise zone as defined by the federal office of
- 13 management and budget, or the percent of households receiving public assistance; and
- 14 (2) The unemployment level within the enterprise zone.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
