It is Resolved by the General Assembly as follows:

RESOLVED: That the sum of \$75,000 be and same is hereby appropriated out of money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987 to be expended by the City of Providence to establish a Police Family Crisis Intervention Team. The purpose of which is to address the problem of family violence and disintegration by providing a team of two social workers and police officers from the Providence Police Department who will provide emergency counselling and referral service when a crisis arises. This Crisis Intervention Team will operate on a 24-hour basis and will be monitored by the Providence Police Department.

EXPLANATION

To fund in the amount of \$75,000, a Police Family Crisis Intervention Team in the City of Providence.
