

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 71

Approved February 9, 1978

WHEREAS, Raymond E. Trainor, Jr., former Town Council President of Narragansett, Rhode Island, has departed from this life, and

WHEREAS, A dedicated personality, Mr. Trainor as a young teenager, by virtue of his mental attitude, overcame various physical problems, following of which he has established himself in the political arena and in the business arena, as a person of high repute, and

WHEREAS, A dedicated civil servant in addition to his public life, he fostered civic and cultural projects in the Town of Narragansett, and

WHEREAS, In a broader sense of dedicated public service, he served as President of the Washington County Council of Governments; as Vice-President of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns and in the Fraternal area as Past President of the Narragansett Lions Club; the Mettatuxet Yacht Club and as President of the Quonset Point Alumni Association; as Charter Member of the South County Chapter, Friendly Sons of St. Patrick; as a Member of the Disabled American Veterans, having served four years in the United States Army Air Force, as a Member of the Ryan Post, American Legion and as a Member of the Narragansett Democratic Town Committee,
