No. 112 **AN ORDINANCE** IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 21, SECTION 19 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED: "CAPITAL EQUIPMENT BUDGET," AS AMENDED

*Approved* March 12, 2001

### *Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

Section 1. That the City of Providence (Providence School Department) enter into a lease purchase agreement to finance the purchase of the following list of capital items and improvements totaling \$2,300,000 subsequently in accordance with the attached schedule of estimated payments.
