ANTHONY B. SCIARRETTA, ESQUIRE, only nominee, was nominated to succeed himself for the term of Six (6) Years ending on the first Thursday in November, 1995, at the regular meeting of the City Council held on THURSDAY, OCTOBER 5, 1989, which date has allowed for the elapsed time of twenty days between the nomination and election of the Judge of Probate Court.
