WHEREAS, Within the provisions of these laws, the City Council has been given certain rights in the negotiating process for the citing of these facilities in the City of Providence, and

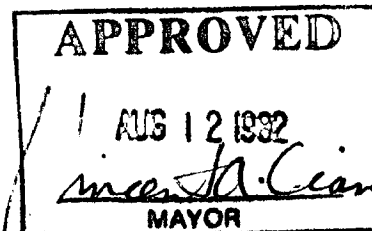

Bendick, Jr., of the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management is hereby requested to notify the members of the Providence City Council, through notification to its' President, of the filing of any application for the citing of a hazardous waste management facility within the City of Providence, or for locating such a facility in any adjoining community which may have an impact in the City of Providence.
