RESOLVED, DECREED, AND ORDERED:

That the following named street shown as an cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island Department of Public Works Engineering Office, Street line Section Plan No. 064639 dated August 3, 1999.

VIZ: Edgewood Boulevard shown as a cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and its proposed to be abandoned as a public highway. Said abandonment and road reconfiguration are specifically conditioned precedent upon the following:

1. That there be no permanent construction on the abandoned portion of Edgewood Boulevard, so that existing facilities of the Providence Water Supply Board remain unencumbered and further, the City of Providence shall retain for itself its heirs, successors and assigns an acceptable easement which will permit retention of its existing Water Supply facilities in its existing locations together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the Petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation, and that no permanent construction, whatsoever, be allowed within the easement.

2. The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Narragansett Electric Company which will permit retention of its facilities in t heir existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.

3. The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Providence Gas Company which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together



with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need to be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the Petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.

4. The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to Bell Atlantic which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the Petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation;


5. A driveway easement shall be granted.

6. The Petitioner shall meet those conditions to which reference is made in that communication from the Providence City Plan Commission dated 27 August, 1999 which states as follows, "(A) The property owner of AP 90, Lot 16 will maintain the new driveway in perpetuity"; "(B) An easement will remain along the abandoned right-of-way so that the property owner of AP 90, Lot 16 may retain an Edgewood Boulevard address and will have access to the front of the property."

8. Upon such other conditions as his Honor, the Mayor, and the City Solicitor shall deem necessary.

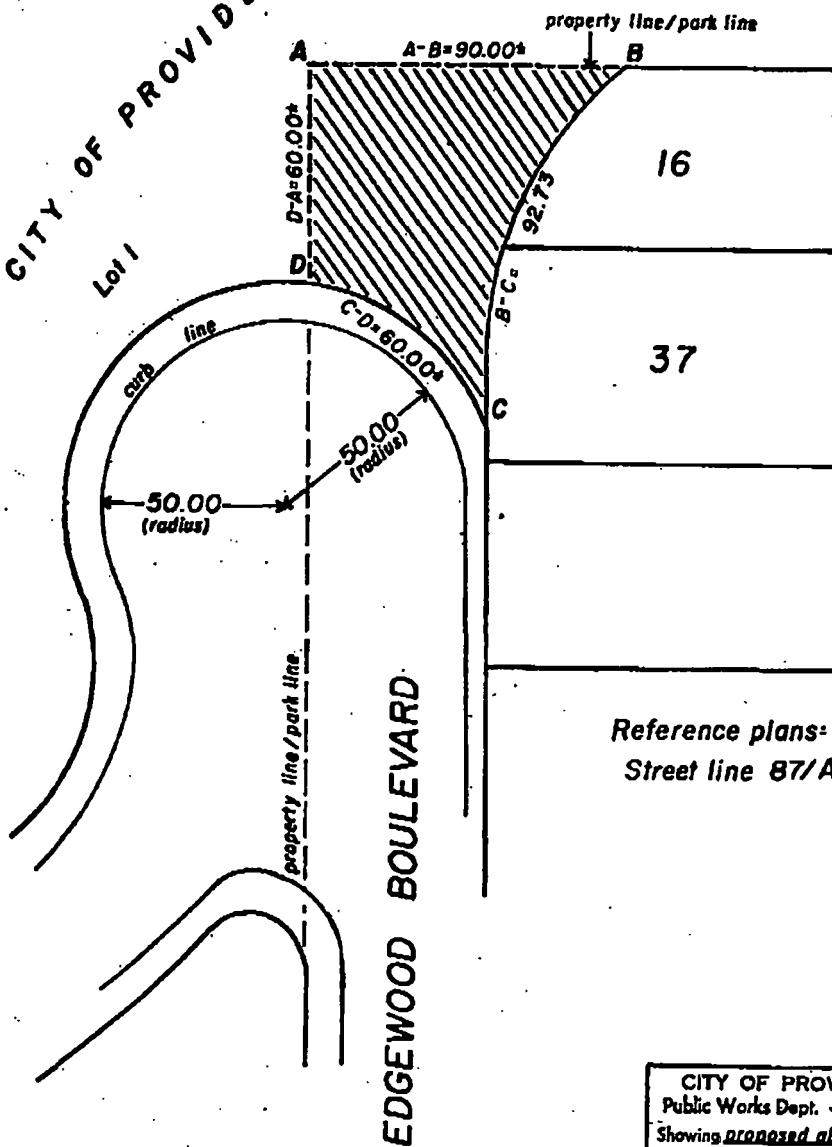

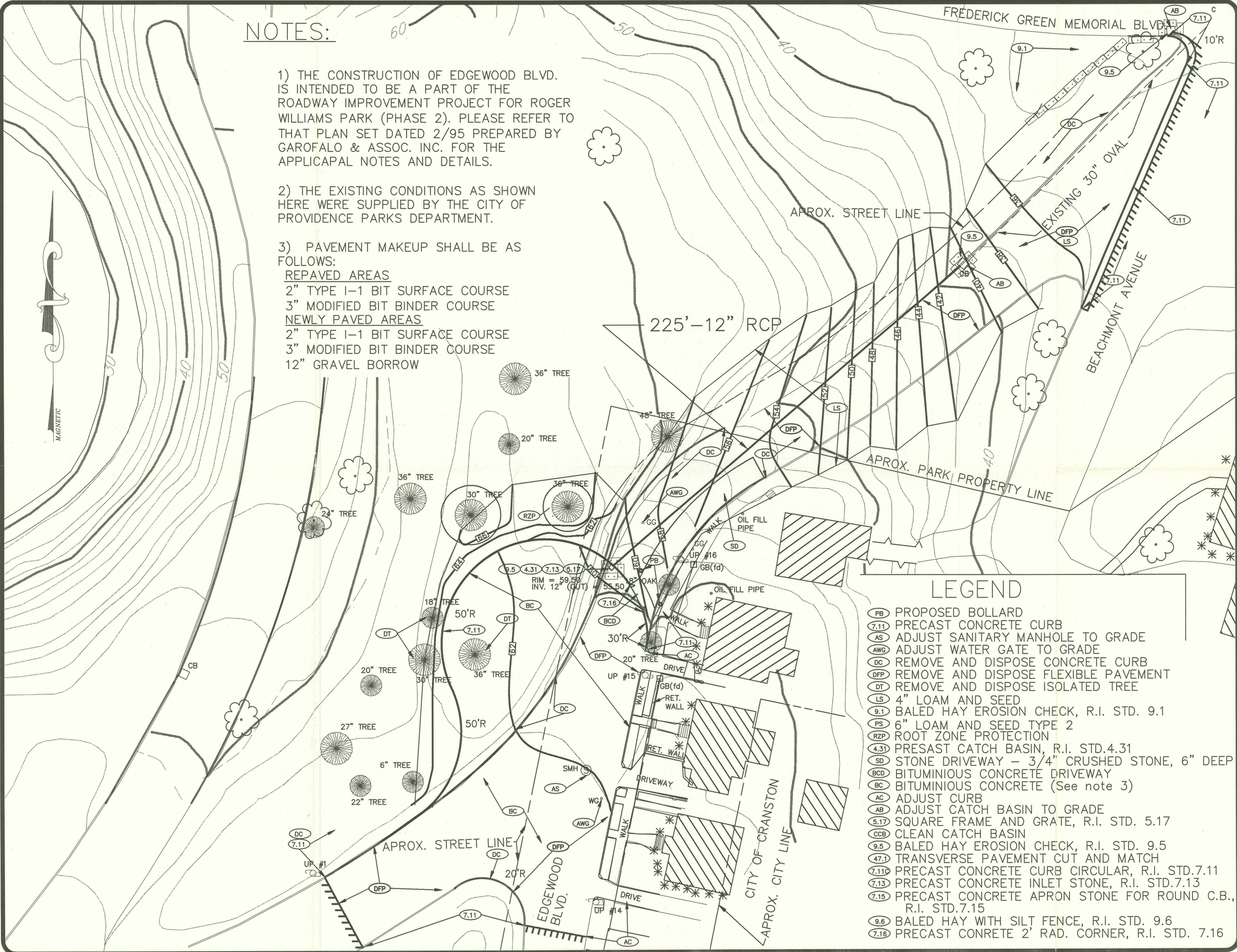

Please forward a formal request to the City Council to abandon a portion of Edgewood Boulevard, with a precise map indicating the boundaries of said portion. As stated in my previous correspondences, a small portion of Edgewood Boulevard belongs to the City within the portion that is being abandoned. A fair amount of research and perhaps surveying is needed to determine the precise boundaries and the Public Works Department records are inconclusive in this regard therefore, it is recommended that the consultant Garafalo & Associates perform this task.

Dear Councilman Clarkin:

The referenced Petition received from the Department of City Clerk proposes to close the northern most end of Edgewood Boulevard, changing the roadway from a through street to a dead end street. The proposed closure or abandonment shall be as indicated on Plan No. 064639, Dated Aug. 3, 1999 which was prepared by the Engineering Office of the City of Providence Public Works Department.

Accordingly, we have reviewed the Petition with respect to the impact it may have on the Providence Water Supply Board (PWSB) Distribution System. Presently our records indicate that PWSB owns and maintains a 6-inch cast iron water main and a 30-inch prestressed concrete cylinder pipeline (PCCP) water main in the portion of Edgewood Boulevard being proposed for closure (abandonment).

The 6-inch water main services two (2) properties along Edgewood Boulevard and must remain as situated in the event the Petition is approved. The 30-inch PCCP water main is a major transmission main servicing the easterly portion of our distribution system and currently is the source of supply to the East Bay Pipeline which ultimately feeds the Bristol County Water Authority. As such, the 30-inch main must also remain in place.


PWSB has no objection to the proposed street closure (abandonment), provided that the Petitioners grant a full utility easement to the PWSB to maintain, construct, repair, etc. the existing water mains and appurtenances, and that no permanent construction, whatsoever, be allowed within the easement. Wording of the easement shall be subject to review by PWSB as to form and content.

CPC Referral No. 3156. Petition to abandon the northern portion of Edgewood Boulevard that begins at Beachmont Avenue and goes one block into the right-of-way.

Dear Councilman Clarkin:

The City Plan Commission at its regular meeting on Tuesday, August 17, 1999, reviewed and evaluated the request from the Committee on Public Works on the petition to abandon a portion of Edgewood Boulevard, more precisely at 2 and 8 Edgewood Boulevard.

The petitioners are the residents of Edgewood Boulevard who request that a part of the street be closed off for the purpose of re-routing drivers through Roger Williams Park. A partial cul-de-sac would be created on Edgewood Boulevard, where at one time cars would turn right onto Beachmont Avenue, to become a dead-end street. Vehicles will now enter from Park Avenue to connect with the Frederick Green Memorial Boulevard and continue onto the remainder portion of the right-of-way.

The Commission has reviewed and evaluated the request for consistency with the City's Comprehensive Plan. The Commission found the proposed abandonment of said right-of-way is consistent with *Providence 2000: The Comprehensive Plan*.

The City Plan Commission voted to recommend that the Committee on Public Works approve the proposed abandonment, as shown in the Public Works Street Line Section, with the following condition:

1. The property owner of AP 90, Lot 16 will maintain the new driveway in perpetuity, and
2. An easement will remain along the abandoned right-of-way so that the property owner of AP 90, Lot 16 may retain an Edgewood Boulevard address and will have access to the front of the property.


Bell Atlantic presently has aerial facilities in said street.

RESOLVED, DECREED, AND ORDERED:

That the following named street shown as an cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island Department of Public Works Engineering Office, Street line Section Plan No. 064639 dated August 3, 1999.

VIZ: Edgewood Boulevard shown as a cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and its proposed to be abandoned as a public highway. Said abandonment and road reconfiguration are specifically conditioned precedent upon the following:

1. That there be no permanent construction on the abandoned portion of Edgewood Boulevard, so that existing facilities of the Providence Water Supply Board remain unencumbered and further, the City of Providence shall retain for itself its heirs, successors and assigns an acceptable easement which will permit retention of its existing Water Supply facilities in its existing locations together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the Petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation, and that no permanent construction, whatsoever, be allowed within the easement.

2. The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Narragansett Electric Company which will permit retention of its facilities in t heir existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.

3. The Petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Providence Gas Company which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together

with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four (24) hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the Petitioner that any such facilities need to be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the Petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.



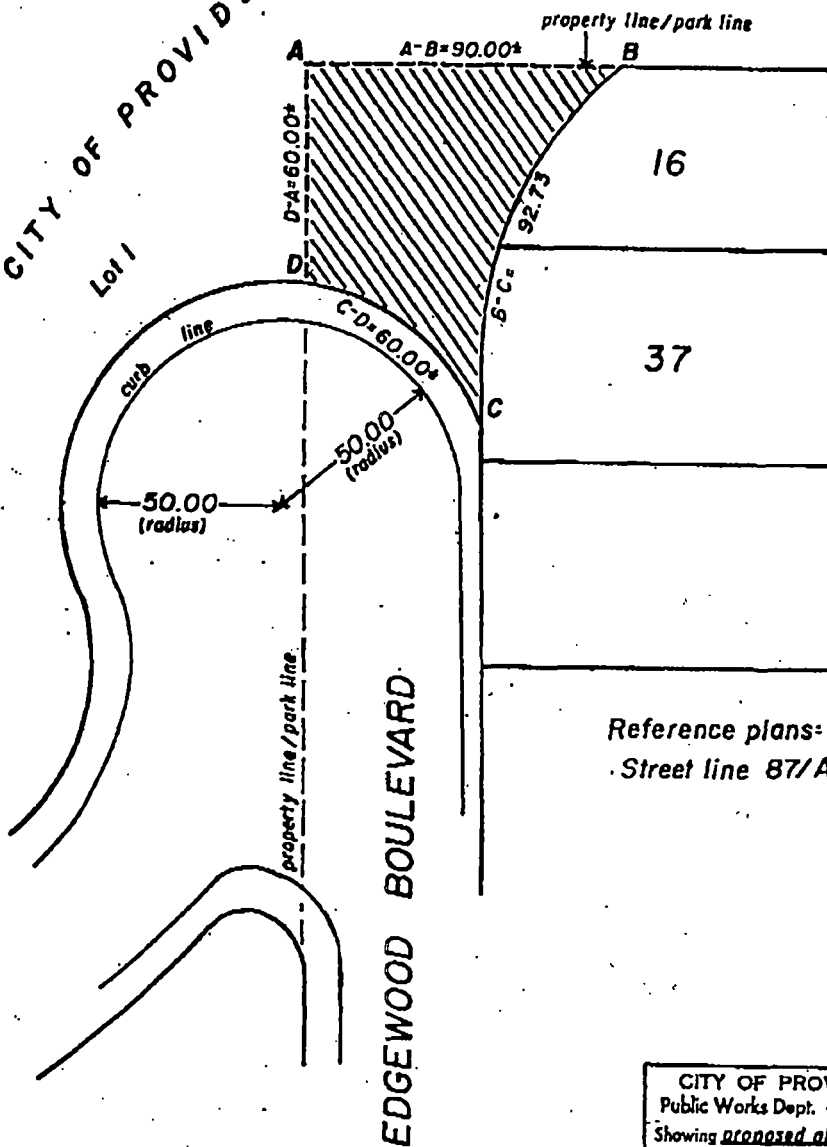
