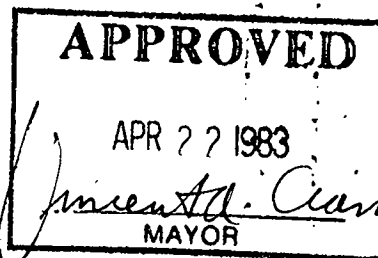

Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolutions from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

✓ Request: That Thayer Street be established as a one-way street in a northerly direction from Transit Street to Arnold Street.

Disposition: Denied. Due to the low traffic volumes in this area of Thayer Street, we see no need to establish this street as a one way street.

Request: To establish a 4-way STOP control at the intersection of Daniel Avenue and Harlam Street.

Disposition: Denied. This intersection does not meet the warrants required for a four-way STOP control.

Request: To establish East Orchard Avenue between Butler Avenue and Patterson Street as a one way street during certain shcool hours on school days.

Disposition. No objection, although I feel that it would be difficult to implement such a regulation.

Request: That Westcott Avenue in a southerly direction and Herschel Street in a northerly direction be established as one way streets.

Disposition: Denied. No warrants are meet for the establishment of a one way traffic pattern in this area.

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to reverse the direction of the one way pattern along Ralph Street and Rye Street between Dorchester Avenue and Plainfield Street.

Disposition: Please submit to this office further information as to why this request is being made.

Request: To establish a 4-way STOP control at the intersection of Ivy Street and Dana Street.

Disposition: Denied. This intersection does not meet the warrants required for a four way STOP control.
