RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 196

Approved April 7, 1976

RESOLVED, that the City Solicitor is requested to urge passage of an Act recommending to the Department of Education it provide thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction for voter education to students who attain Seventeen (17) years of age in each of the High Schools within the State of Rhode Island, which instruction shall be given by a person eligible for a teacher's certificate issued under the authority of the State Board of Education and which course of instruction shall be approved by the State Board of Education and the State Board of Elections, so that prospective first time voters may become acquainted with election laws, procedures and ballot and machine voting.
