

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved April 8, 1999

WHEREAS, The Director of Public Works is hereby requested to study the status of curb cuts in the City of Providence and to initiate a plan to cause certain curb cuts to be made on every sidewalk in the City, and

WHEREAS, The Americans with Disabilities Act passed by Congress requires that access be given to disabled persons and it is evident that assessment of accessibility should be made and implemented as soon as possible, and

WHEREAS, The Providence City Council along with the Mayor's Office and the Director of Public Works should press and demand that curb cuts should be made throughout the City in order that we, as the Governing Agency for the City of Providence should show our concern for those who are confined to wheelchairs, or have mobility or visual impairments, and

WHEREAS, These barriers should be eliminated to allow this group of people to travel along our City sidewalks without any hindrance at all, and

WHEREAS, The City Council does hereby request that the Director of Public Works after such study, begin to construct, renovate, repair and maintain these said curb cuts and sidewalks throughout the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council along with His Honor the Mayor be very instrumental in initiating such a plan and try to lift these barriers, to allow our handicapped citizens free access along all City sidewalks here in the City of Providence.
