RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 253

Approved March 21, 1983

WHEREAS, The Festival of Historic Houses, conducted annually by the Providence Preservation Society is of significant benefit to the City, and

WHEREAS, The 1983 Festival will be held on May 6 and 7, 1983 and requires certain actions by the City,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That

1. Benefit Street, from Meeting Street to Church Street and the adjacent side streets known as Cady, Bowen and Church Streets be closed to vehicular traffic from 7:00 o'clock P.M. to 10:00 o'clock P.M. on Friday, May 6, 1983 and during the same hours on Saturday, May 7, 1983.

2. The Traffic Engineer and Police Department are requested to cause the streets in the five-block area, bounded by Congdon Street, Meeting Street, Prospect Street and Jenckes Street be closed to vehicular traffic from 10:00 o'clock A.M. to 4:00 o'clock P.M. on Saturday, May 7, 1983.

3. The Department of Public Parks is hereby requested to permit the Providence Preservation Society and their guests who are participating in the Festival of Historic Houses to use Prospect Park on Saturday, May 7, 1983 from 10:00 o'clock A.M. to 5:00 o'clock P.M.

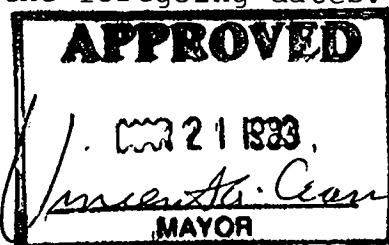
4. The Department of Public Works is hereby requested to cause each of the above referenced streets to be swept immediately prior to the above dates.

5. The Department of Public Parks and Department of Public Works are hereby requested to ensure that any litter resulting from the foregoing activities is collected from available receptacles immediately following the foregoing dates.
