

Dear Councilman Matera:

Under date of April 3, we received a memorandum from the Office of the City Clerk regarding the Wardlaw Terrace Plat. We obtained a copy of the plat from the City Engineer's Office and find that in order to supply water to the properties shown on the Wardlaw Terrace Plat, it will be necessary to extend the water main in Wardlaw Avenue for a distance of about 368 ft. No main will be required in Floral Drive as these lots may be supplied from intersecting streets.

Subject: Wardlaw Terrace Plat

The proposed plat entitled "Wardlaw Terrace" has been reviewed by this office and the following comments and recommendations are made:

Plat proposes to extend Wardlaw Avenue in a westerly direction until it terminates in a dead end. Development of dead end streets without provision for vehicle turn around is contrary to all good engineering practice, and creates a very hazardous traffic condition. This is especially true during the winter months when snow removal equipment will be forced to back out of the street.

In addition, the plan of the proposed plat has not been certified by a Registered Professional Engineer or Professional Land Surveyor as required by law.

Because of the extremely serious engineering deficiencies heretofore mentioned, this plat is not satisfactory and it is therefore recommended that the petition to receive this plat be denied.

This referral is a request for study, report and recommendation relative to the accompanying plan entitled "Wardlaw Terrace". The area is bounded by a segment of Wardlaw Avenue, Floral Drive, Sharon Street and Stonelaw Avenue. The area in question contains 106,124 square feet of land and is located in an R-1 Zone.


On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the property in question contains open farm land with a 1½-story frame dwelling, two 1½-story frame storage sheds and unsheltered floral beds and foundations.

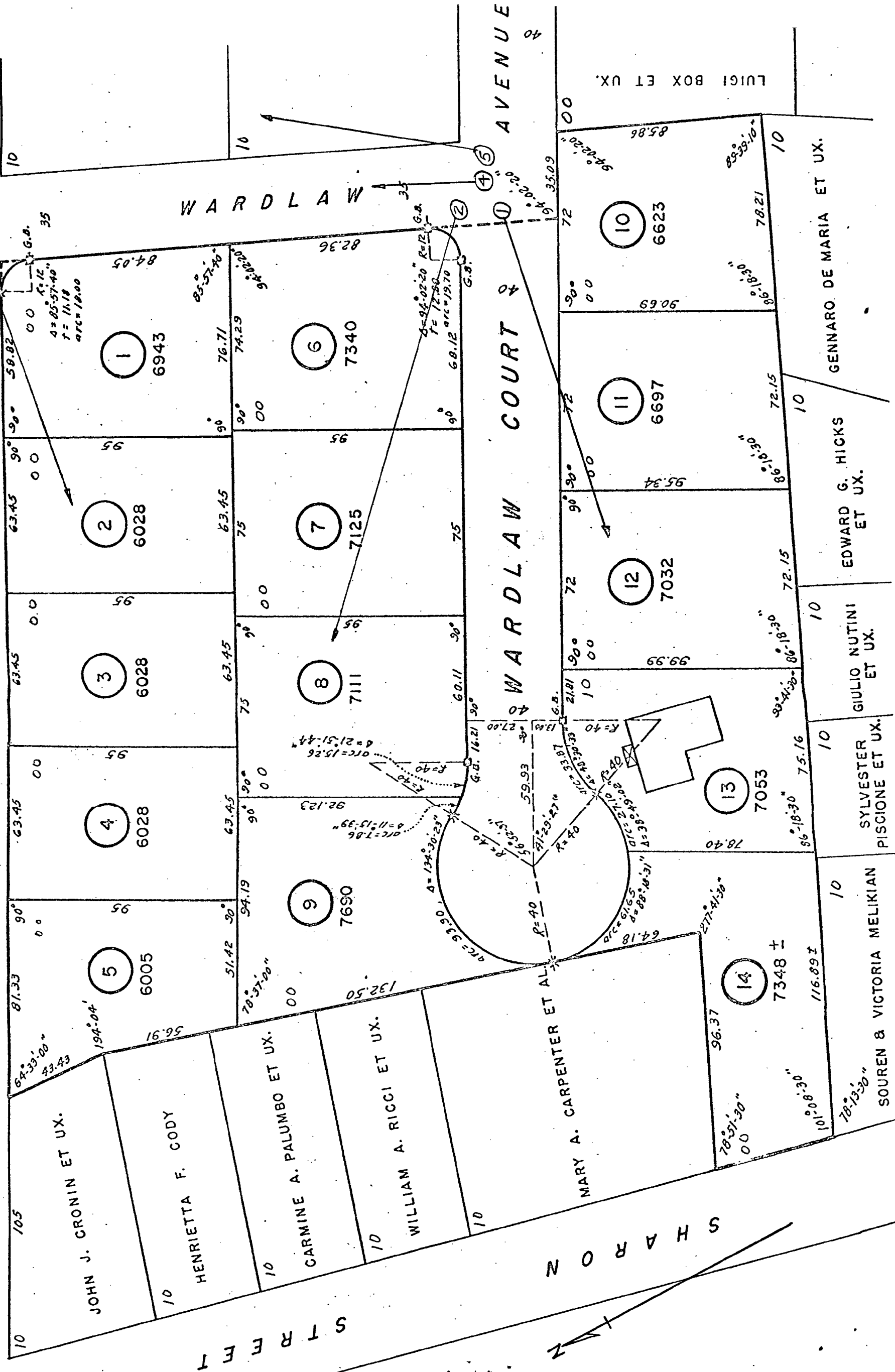
