ELECTION OF JUDGE OF PROBATE COURT OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE

The City Council proceeds to elect a Judge of Probate Court in accordance with the provisions of Section XI of Chapter 3340 of the Public Laws of 1954, approved April 26, 1954, entitled, "An Act in Amendment of Clause I of Section XI of Chapter 598 of the Public Laws, 1866, as amended, relating to the Probate Court of the City of Providence.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY B. SCJARRETTA and JOHN B. KELAGHAN, ESQUIRE, were nominated for the remainder of the term ending on the First Thursday, in November, 1977, at the regular meeting of the City Council held on Thursday, May 3, 1973, which date has allowed for the elapsed time of twenty days between nomination and the election of a Judge of Probate Court, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Francis B. Brown, Esquire, former Judge of the said Court.

The nominations of COUNCILMAN ANTHONY B. SCJARRETTA and JOHN B. KELAGHAN, ESQUIRE, as Judge of the Probate Court of the City of Providence are thereupon severally taken from the City Clerk's desk, on motion of COUNCILMAN LYNCH, seconded by COUNCILMEN LORENZO AND PRETE.

The City Council thereupon proceeds to elect a Judge of the Probate Court of the City of Providence, from amongst the nominees: Councilman Anthony B. Sciarretta and John B. Kelaghan, Esquire, by the following viva voice vote by roll call:
