The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following Resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a blinker traffic control signal light at the intersection of Charles Street with Ledge Street, and the posting of speed limit signs along Charles Street, from Branch Avenue to the City Line.

Disposition: This department does not feel that a traffic signal is warranted at said intersection at this time. The accident history is good at this location. The existing STOP control at this intersection serves the same purpose of a blinker traffic control.

There are presently signs posted along Charles Street indicating that the speed limit is 25 M.P.H.
