RESOLUTION GRANTING ACCOMPANYING PETITION OF PROVIDENCE SHERATON CORPORATION AND NATIONAL GARAGES OF RHODE ISLAND, INC. FOR PERMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A BRIDGE OVER AND ACROSS EDDY STREET.

RESOLVED, that pursuant to authority contained in Chapter 104 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island, January Session, 1963 and the further authority of an Act of the General Assembly, page 1070, Rhode Island Acts and Resolves, January Session, 1962 permission be granted to Providence Sheraton Corporation and National Garages of Rhode Island, Inc. to construct and maintain a bridge over and across Eddy Street in the City of Providence for the purpose of connecting the building owned by the Providence Sheraton Corporation and the proposed building to be constructed by National Garages of Rhode Island, Inc. or its nominee, said buildings to be located on opposite sides of Eddy Street and of providing passageway between said buildings.

The permission hereby granted is upon the following conditions: (1) that said bridge shall be constructed under supervision and subject to the approval of the Director of the Department of Building Inspection of the City of Providence and the City Engineer of said City; (2) that every part of such bridge shall be at least fourteen (14) feet above the surface of said Eddy Street; (3) that the said Providence Sheraton Corporation and National Garages of Rhode Island, Inc. shall hold and keep said City of Providence harmless, safe and indemnified from and against loss, cost, damage, payment and expense on account of injuries to persons or damage to property for which said City may become liable on account of the construction and maintenance, use, repair or neglect to repair, or any defect of said bridge over and across Eddy Street, unless the wrongful act or negligence of said City, its officers or employees shall cause such injury or damage; (4) that before commencing work of constructing said bridge, Providence Sheraton

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body

WHEREAS your petitioners, Providence Sheraton Corporation and National Garages of Rhode Island, Inc. are owners of real estate abutting Eddy Street between Washington Street and Worcester Street; and

WHEREAS your petitioners have entered into an agreement whereby National Garages of Rhode Island, Inc. will construct a multi level garage on land bounding on said Eddy Street opposite the premises of the Providence Sheraton Corporation; and

WHEREAS, your petitioners desire to construct between the two buildings over and across Eddy Street a bridge or passageway, which will provide for the public's safety, convenience and protection in passing between said garage and hotel of your petitioners; and

WHEREAS said bridge over and across Eddy Street will promote and improve the downtown area; and

WHEREAS by and Act of the General Assembly, January Session A.D. 1962, page 1070, Rhode Island Acts and Resolves, Providence Sheraton Corporation was authorized and empowered to build and maintain a bridge or passageway over and across Eddy Street, whenever a permit therefore shall be granted by the City Council of the City of Providence; and by Chapter 104 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island enacted at the January Session, 1963, your honorable body was granted power to permit the building and maintenance of bridges over and across streets and highways in the City for the purpose of connecting buildings and providing passageways between them;



WHEREAS, your petitioner, R. Einar Soderback, Superintendent of Public Buildings of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, owner of school buildings now under construction and abutting Winter Street between Cranston Street and Broad Street; and

WHEREAS, your petitioner desires to construct between the buildings over and across Winter Street a pedestrian bridge or passageway, which will provide for the public's safety, convenience and protection in passing between said buildings of your petitioner; and

WHEREAS, your petitioner desires to construct between the buildings under and across Winter Street two (2) conduits for heating purposes and one (1) conduit for electrical purposes which will provide for the public's safety, convenience and protection in the use of these buildings and which will provide for the safety, convenience and protection of the student occupants, faculty occupants and other occupants of the buildings of your petitioner; and

On an inspection survey it was determined that the pedestrian bridge or passageway would run from Central High School over Winter Street and connect with the school building presently under construction.



RESOLVED, That permission be and hereby is granted to the Roman Catholic Diocese of Providence, a corporation sole, to construct, install and maintain an underground tunnel or subway to be used for the purpose of conveying steam and electric lines and for passage under and across Fenner Street in the City of Providence, all in accordance with the accompanying plan attached hereto, entitled, " Drawing H-101 'Plan and Profile of Underground Conduit across Fenner Street' dated November 28, 1966" as approved by the Director of Public Works of the City of Providence and the Public Service Engineer, and in accordance with the provisions of "An Act Authorizing the City of Providence to Permit the Owners or Owners of Estates Situated upon Opposite sides of a Street or Highway to Build and Maintain a Subway, Conduit or Pipe under or across Such Street or Highway," being Chapter 1418 of the Public Laws, approved April 4, 1916.

The permission hereby granted is upon the condition that said underground tunnel or subway shall be so constructed as not to interfere with the use of said Fenner Street, by the public or by any person or corporations having the right to maintain pipes or conduits under or in said street; and it is further provided that the permission hereby granted is upon the condition that said underground tunnel or subway shall be constructed under the supervision and control and to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works, and upon the condition that said underground tunnel or subway shall be removed upon 90 (ninty) days' previous notice from the City Council whenever in the opinion of said City Council the public interest may require the removal of the same or any part thereof; and upon the condition that in case the City of Providence shall at any time hereafter be authorized to assess abutting owners for the private use and occupation of the public highway, the passage of this Resolution shall not in any manner affect the right of the City to charge and collect rent for the use of said Fenner Street by said Roman Catholic Dioces of Providence, its successors and assigns, or for maintaining thereunder said underground tunnel or subway and upon condition that said Roman Catholic Diocese of Providence, a corporation sole, its successors and assigns, shall hold and keep said City of Providence harmless, safe and indemnified from and against all loss, cost, damage, payment and expense on account of any injuries to persons, or damage to property, for which said City may become liable on account of the construction, maintenance, use or repair, or neglect

to properly maintain or repair, or any defect of said underground tunnel or subway or the pipes, wires, or other facility therein under and across said Fenner Street, unless the wrongful act or negligence of said City, its officers or employees, shall cause such injury or damage as mentioned aforesaid; and upon condition that said Roman Catholic Diocese of Providence, a corporation sole, its successors and assigns before commencing the work of constructing said tunnel or conduit file a bond in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, in form satisfactory to the City Solicitor to hold and keep said City harmless, safe and indemnified as aforesaid, and it is agreed by the acceptance hereof that the amount of said bond shall not be construed or held to limit their general obligation to hold and keep said City harmless, safe and indemnified as aforesaid; and upon the condition that said Roman Catholic Diocese of Providence, its successors and assigns, shall repair and keep in repair so much of said Fenner Street, and the sidewalks of said Fenner Street at and near where said underground tunnel or subway crosses the same as shall be required by the Director of Public Works and to his satisfaction, and also upon the condition that said Roman Catholic Diocese of Providence, a corporation sole, its successors and assigns, shall before commencing the construction of said underground conduit, file with the City Clerk a written acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Resolution and an agreement to perform and observe all of said terms and conditions.

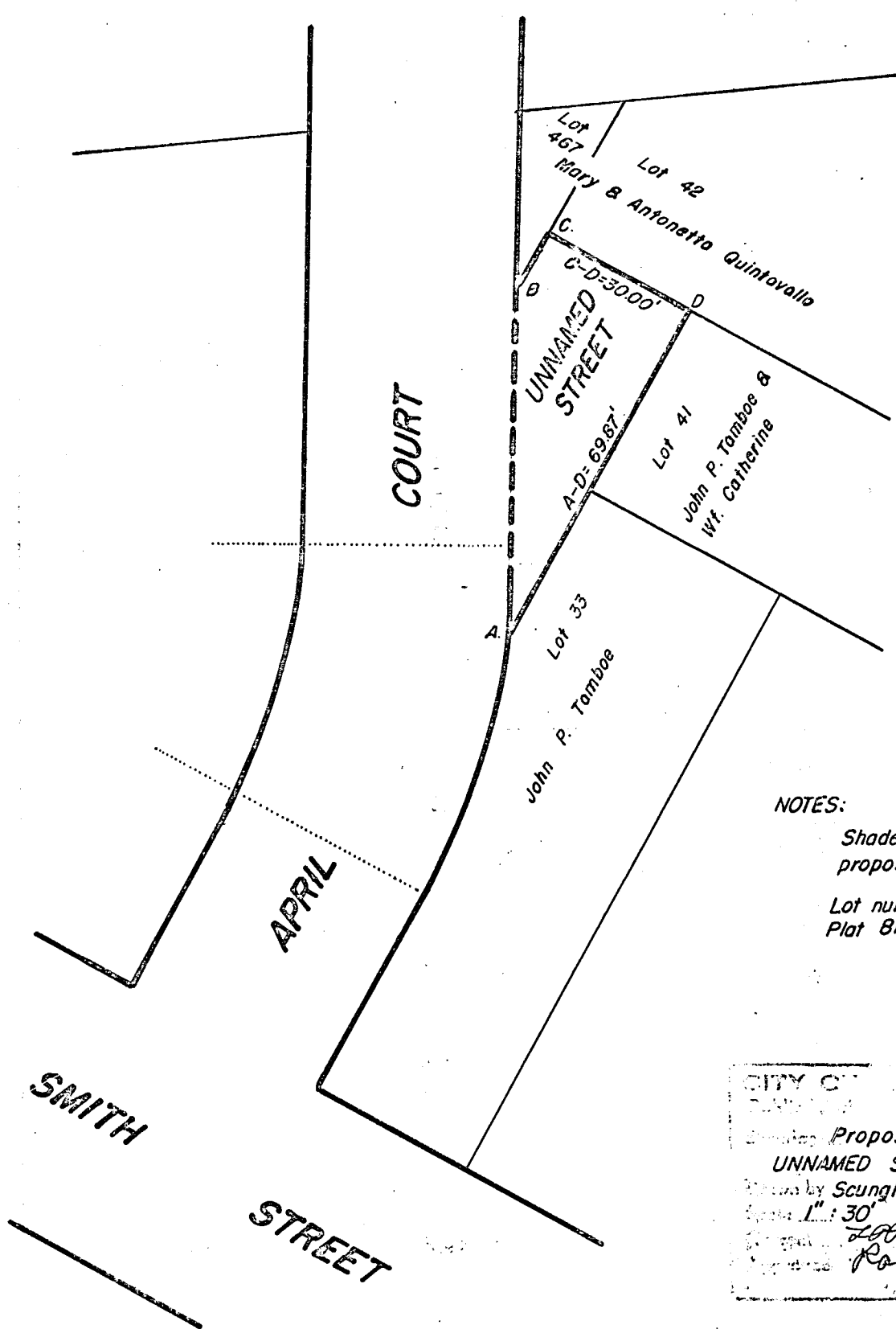
