## PRESENTATION OF RESOLUTION

### COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI:

Resolution Declaring a vacancy in the Office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh Ward of the City of Providence caused by the resignation of the Honorable Councilman David V. Igliazzi and ordering that a Special Election be held for the purpose of filling said vacancy in accordance with Section 206 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980.

*Whereas*, Section 206(a)(4) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980 provides that in the event an incumbent elected official resigns, the City Council shall declare the office held by the resigned official vacant; and

*Whereas*, The resignation of the Honorable David V. Igliazzi on August 18, 1997 has caused a vacancy to exist in the Office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh Ward; and

*Whereas*, Said vacancy did occur less than one hundred eighty (180) days before the time of holding the next succeeding regular city election; and

*Whereas*, In accordance with the provisions of Section 206(b) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, a Special Election for the purpose of filling the vacancy be held within ninety (90) days of the occurrence of said vacancy; and

*Whereas*, Section 17-15-3 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island provides that a primary election for the nomination of such city or town officials be held and the local board shall fix the date thereof; provided, however, that said primary election shall have been held by the thirtieth (30) day preceding the date fixed for said election;

*Now, therefore, be it Resolved*, That pursuant to Section 206(a)(4) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, the City Council declares that a vacancy exists in the Office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh Ward caused by the resignation of the Honorable David V. Iglizoi; and that in accordance with Section 206(b) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, the City Council does hereby order that a Special Election be held on November 13, 1997, for the purpose of filling said vacancy, said Special Election being held within ninety (90) days of the occurrence of said vacancy; and

*Be it further Resolved*, That the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, and all other officers whose duty it is to prepare for elections, are hereby requested and notified to make such preparations for said Special Election as required by law, and

*Be it further Resolved*, That the City Clerk is directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Board of Canvassers and Registration and also that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the State Board of Elections and to the Honorable Secretary of State.

**Read and Passed, on motion of COUNCILWOMAN WILLIAMS, seconded by COUNCILWOMAN YOUNG.**

**The motion for Passage is Unanimously Sustained.**
