WHEREAS, The Mayor's goal is to alleviate the need for a property tax cut in fiscal 1996, and

WHEREAS, The future of the City of Providence relies on a healthy balanced budget with the lowest possible tax burden on the citizens and businesses of Providence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council does hereby offer its full support to the Mayor in reducing the costs of City Government and in seeking alternative revenue sources to balance the 1996 budget and to minimize the Tax Rate.

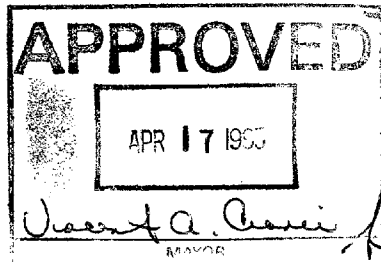

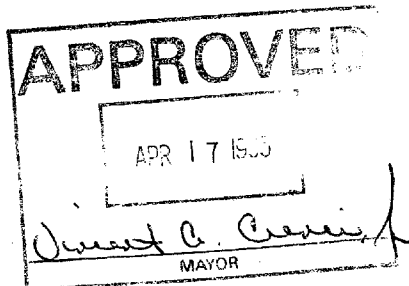
