CHAPTER 1087

No. 127 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTIONS 170 and
171 OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1946 RELATING
TO RELIEF OF INJURED EMPLOYEES.

Approved February 25, 1957

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Sections 170 and 171 of Chapter 2 of the
Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence (1946) as
amended by Chapter 549 of the Ordinances of 1951 and further
amended by Chapter 970 of the Ordinances of 1955, are hereby
further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 170. COMMISSION FOR THE RELIEF OF INJURED
EMPLOYEES. The Mayor, the Director of Public Works,
the Personnel Director and the Finance Director
are hereby created a Commission with authority
to provide for the relief of such employees of
the various departments of the City, excluding
policemen and firemen, employees of the school
department and employees otherwise provided for
who shall be injured or disabled while in the
actual discharge of their duties as such employees
and as a result thereof, in accordance with and
subject to the following conditions:

"Sec. 171. SAME PAYMENTS TO SUCH EMPLOYEES.
When any such employee shall be injured or disabled while
in the actual discharge of his duties as such employee
and as a result thereof, said commission, in its dis-
cretion, may order that such employee be paid such sum
of money, at such time or times or for such period, as
it may determine to be just and proper; and said sums
shall be charged to the appropriation for the department
in which such employee is employed. Such allowance shall
not exceed the sum of twelve hundred (\$1,200) dollars
in all to any one person during the continuance of his
injury or disability."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage
and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith
are hereby repealed.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 163.1 of Article XV of the 1946
Revised Ordinances entitled "Officers and Employees
Generally", as amended is hereby further amended to read
as follows:

"Sec. 163.1 Vacations with pay--Employees entitled to two
weeks annually.

"All officers and permanent employees of the city who have been
continuously in the employ of the city for at least one year
shall be entitled to an annual vacation of two calendar weeks
with pay during each succeeding year of their employment, ex-
cept that as of January 1, 1957, and as of January 1 in each
year thereafter, all officers and employees who have been con-
tinuously in the employ of the city for ten years or more,
shall be entitled to three calendar weeks with pay during
each ensuing year of their employment."

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 1051 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1956, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$33,514,967.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1957", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred (\$2,200) Dollars to GRANTS TO OUTSIDE AGENCIES AND INSTITUTIONS-AMBULANCE FOR RHODE ISLAND HOSPITAL.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred (\$2,200) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Two Thousand and Two Hundred (\$2,200) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 1051 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1956, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$33,514,967.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1957", as amended, is hereby further amended by transferring from WATER FUND-PAYMENT TO SINKING FUNDS, Fourteen Hundred (\$1400) Dollars to Water Fund-Administration, Item 3; Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars to Water Fund-Source of Supply, Item 3; Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars to Water Fund-Transmission and Distribution, Item 3; and Eighteen Hundred (\$1800) Dollars to Water Fund-Meter Division, Item 3.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Seventy Seven Hundred (\$7700) Dollars as thus transferred shall be obtained by transferring a like amount from Water Fund-Payment to Sinking Funds, Item 8.
