WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island has, from time to time, exempted from taxation, certain Educational Institutions, and

WHEREAS, the same tax exemptions are affecting the financial status of the various Cities and Towns in the State of Rhode Island by depriving the same from financial assistance conducting their respective Governmental functions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Assembly is hereby requested at its January Session, 1978, to re-evaluate its policy of exempting from taxation all Educational Institutions so that the same will not burden Cities and Towns in which they are located with the cost of Governmental Services which are borne entirely by Taxpayers in the said Cities and Towns in the State of Rhode Island.
