

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 300

Approved June 11, 1973

WHEREAS, Peter Syintsakos, Jr., gallant young member of the Armed Forces of the United States of America, lost his life while on combat duty in Vietnam, and

WHEREAS, young Peter's host of friends desire that the sacrifice he paid with his life not go unnoticed and suggests that a perpetual memorial to his memory be effected,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the intersection of Harold Street with Aurora Street, in the City of Providence, be designated as "Peter Syintsakos, Jr. Memorial Square", and the Waters-Langton Post No. 228, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States of America, upon whose recommendation this memorial is established, be authorized to conduct dedicatory exercises for the designation of "Peter Syintsakos, Jr. Memorial Square".
