RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 4

Approved January 7, 1980

RESOLVED, That the City Solicitor is requested to cause to be introduced and to urge passage at the 1980 Session of the General Assembly of an Act in amendment of and in addition to Title 11, Chapter 34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, entitled "Prostitution and Lewdness", by adding the following:

"Section 11 - 34 - 8. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to stand or wander about any public place, public highway, and/or street, and repeatedly attempt to engage passersby in conversation, or ^{repeatedly} ~~reportedly~~ stop or attempt to ^{Rmm} stop motor vehicles ^{in all such cases} for the purpose of prostitution or of patronizing a prostitute, said person or persons shall be guilty of loitering in a public place, and shall be liable to be imprisoned up to one (1) year or fined up to five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or both.

This Act shall take effect upon its passage."
