Resolution approving the accompanying plat entitled Dedication of Woodbine Park, Mount Hope Urban Renewal Project R. I. R-18, Providence Redevelopment Agency, Stanley P. Blacher, Chairman, et al, Scale 1" = 50.0' dedicating for Park purposes a certain tract or parcel of land, situated at the southerly street line of Woodbine Street shown as a cross-hatched area and designated by the letters, A-B-C-D-E-F containing 7,765 plus or minus square feet on the accompanying plan under the provisions of Chapter 987 of the Public Laws of 1913 and thereafter declared a public Park to be repaired and maintained at the expense of the City of Providence.




AREA LETTERED A-B-C-D-E-F-A
