

As you requested, the following is a description of an ordinance which would change the zones in which Drug or Alcoholic Rehabilitation Centers are permitted within the City. This ordinance would change these areas from permitted to special exceptions in C2, C4 and W2 Zones. The ordinance would have to amend Section 303, Use Regulations, of the City of Providence Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 1991-29, No. 564, approved October 24, 1991. Section 303, Use Table 2.0, Section 24.4, would have to be amended to read as shown on the following page.
