

4	Drainage at 65-67 Bellevue Ave	DPW has obtained a budgetary quote of approximately \$13,000 to make drainage modifications at 65-67 Bellevue Ave. We are attempting to identify a funding source to complete this work.
7, 8, 9	Repair sidewalks	The locations have been referred to the Highway Div for investigation.
10	4-way STOP; Kossuth & Putnam	Speed was measured and it is not a factor; there are insufficient accidents to warrant a 4-way STOP.
11	One-way during school hours for Terrace Ave	Traffic Regulation No. 824 was prepared; pending sign fabrication and installation
12, 13, 14	One-way: Appleton, Florence, Chaffee	Subject to final approval by City Council
15	All-way STOP at Lawn and Farm	Reviewing accident history as required by law
16	One-way Corinth St	Require a City council resolution to complete
17	Four-way STOP at Brighton and Knight	Data collection not complete

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
