Honored Colleagues:

I have this date filed with the Board of Canvassers of the City of Providence a change of residency which necessitates by our Charter my immediate resignation. Accordingly, I herewith respectfully submit to you my resignation as a Member of the City Council to become effective upon your pleasure.

After almost twelve continuous years of service, I am most impressed with the calibre and integrity and effort of my colleagues over the years. The effects of the effort are visibly indicated by a now healthy economic condition and social climate. We've been aided by the cooperation of a good Democratic administration.

The impact of these years has been indelibly impressed upon the history of our City. Not only do we see new skylines and buildings but we now employ methods of operation of government and enjoy improved educational facilities that were not dreamed of ten years ago. All of this has been accomplished during a period of unusual inflation and without a commensurate increase of monetary burden of the residents of the City or with a disastrous impact on our residential areas as has been experienced in other cities of our size.

I believe that the future of our City is good and I leave the City Council, regretfully, with the reassuring knowledge that our City remains financially stable and our goals definitive.
