# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 509

Approved August 15, 1980

WHEREAS, On July 29, 1976, a Resolution No. 403, was adopted by the City Council reducing the width of Boundary Avenue by ten (10) feet, and

WHEREAS, Said Resolution has subsequently been rescinded by this Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, In substitution therefore the following described property, as cross-hatched on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence Rhode Island, Public Works Department-Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 064127, dated July 28, 1980", having ceased to be useful to the public, is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing, and so awarded.

Said Property is described as:

1. That Five Foot (5') portion of Boundary Avenue parallel with the southerly Street Line, from the Westerly Street Line of Killingly Street to the extension of the Northerly Street Line of Myra Street, and
2. That Five Foot (5') portion of Boundary Avenue parallel with the Northerly Street Line, from the Westerly Street Line of Killingly Street to the extension of the Northerly Street Line of Myra Street at a point where it would intersect with the Northerly Street Line of Boundary Avenue.







Referral No. 2023 - Abandonment Portion of Boundary Avenue

A communication from the Committee on Public Works dated December 26, 1979 proposed the abandonment of a portion of Boundary Avenue, a five foot strip parallel with the southerly street line and a five foot strip parallel with the northerly street line of said Boundary Avenue from Killingly Street to Myra Street. This petition was submitted by Councilman Philip Almagno.

A field inspection revealed that Boundary Avenue is an asphalt paved street but it has no sidewalks or curbs. The adjacent land is developed for single family homes. There has been recent construction of high quality houses on both sides of said street. One house at the northerly side of the street is under construction. The area is zoned R-1, one-family zone.

The platted width of Boundary Avenue is 50 feet. Since the residential development of the street is indicated by the new construction and recent built houses, it seems advisable to retain the platted 50 foot width so that sidewalks can be provided at a future date with adequate remaining roadwidth to serve the vehicular traffic.

Therefore, it is recommended by the Department of Planning and Urban Development that the Commission advise the Committee on Public Works that the petition be denied.
