Gentlemen:

As the result of a Resolution to establish a crossing guard post at the intersection of Academy Avenue and Chalkstone Avenue, a survey was conducted. The result revealed that a small number of children used this intersection that is controlled by a traffic signal that can also be controlled by a push-button and the children also use this when crossing. Furthermore, if a post were established at this location there would be difficulty in covering it in the absence of the crossing guard.

I agree with the recommendation of the Police Department that a crossing guard post should not be established at this location.




Dear Sir:
