
Gentlemen:





The Providence Redevelopment Agency in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 11 of Chapter 1419 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved August 10, 1961, and Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports concerning the proposed sale of real property within the Central-Classical Project No. R. I. R-2.

The Agency proposes to sell to the Trinity Union Methodist Church, a parcel of land comprising a total of 43,785 square feet for a total sales price of \$8,757.00. Trinity Union Methodist Church proposes to use this parcel of land as an off-street parking facility for Church functions.




At a meeting of the School Committee held on December 1, 1964,
