No. 488 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES, 1946, BY ADDING ARTICLE XVII ON LICENSE FEES.

Approved August 15, 1957

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances, 1946, entitled "Administration", as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following:

"ARTICLE XVII. License Fees.

STORAGE OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN BULK.

Any person, partnership or corporation or other legal entity storing petroleum products in bulk, shall pay to the City Collector of the City of Providence, the following annual license fees:

FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 1 to 250 GALLONS	NO FEES
FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 251 to 21,000 GALLONS	\$ 10.00 annually
FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 21,001 to 50,000 GALLONS	50.00 annually
FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 50,001 to 100,000 GALLONS	150.00 annually
FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 100,001 to 1,000,000 GALLONS	250.00 annually
FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 1,000,001 to 5,000,000 GALLONS	500.00 annually
FOR PREMISES WITH A STORAGE CAPACITY OF 5,000,001 GALLONS OR OVER	1,000.00 annually
TRANSFER OF LICENSES (EACH)	5.00
PRODUCTS STORED FOR OWN CONSUMPTION AND NOT FOR RESALE	NO FEES."

SEC. 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.



ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR I

CLASS TITLE: Electrical Inspector I

CLASS DEFINITION: Inspects new and existing electrical installations to insure conformity with rules and regulations.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK: Work Involves responsibility for inspection of new and existing electrical installations to insure conformity with established standards. When deemed necessary advice and assistance is available from superior in difficult cases. Work is assigned by a superior and all inspectional reports shall be submitted in written form.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Note: The following examples of work are only illustrative of the kind of work to be performed by persons of this class and are not intended to be all inclusive or exclusive.) Inspects new and existing installations of electrical wires, apparatus and equipment in all types of buildings and other structures to insure conformity with the building code regulating such installations. Checks plans and specifications of proposed electrical installations. Submits reports of violations and issues written or verbal orders for correction of same.

NECESSARY KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Thorough knowledge of building code regulations pertaining to electrical installations. Thorough knowledge of the methods, materials, and techniques of the electrical trade at the journeyman level. Ability in locating defects and hazards in new and existing installations. Ability to successfully meet contractors, property owners, and the general public and to establish effective working relationships.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR APPOINTMENT: Graduation from a standard high or technical school and completion of a recognised apprenticeship under a journeyman electrician or five (5) years experience as a journeyman electrician.

SECTION 1: Chapter 1051 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1956, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$33,514,967.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1957", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars to MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE, ITEM 2.

SECTION 2: The said sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



No. 491 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 1051 BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND
FIFTY-FIVE (\$3,055) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED
THEREIN FOR REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, ITEMS 1 and 2.

Said sum of Three Thousand Fifty-Five (\$3,055) Dollars shall be apportioned as follows: ITEM 1 - \$2,855; ITEM 2 - \$200.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Three Thousand Fifty-Five (\$3,055) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by transferring a like amount from Redevelopment Agency, Item 0.
