No. **292 AN/ORDINANCE** PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS
IN THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$150,000.00) DOLLARS
FOR THE REPAIR OF CLASSICAL HIGH SCHOOL

Approved May 26, 1958

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

WHEREAS, on May 6, 1958 a fire caused serious damage to the property known as Classical High School and an emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of that property, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desiring to take action for the preservation of that property, hereby declares that an emergency situation exists,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

Section 1. The City of Providence will issue bonds of said City in the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$150,000.00) DOLLARS to be designated "Classical High School Fire Damage Bonds" under and by virtue of the authority granted by Section 135 of Chapter 832 of the Public Laws, 1940, the short title of which is "The Providence Charter Act of 1940", as amended by Chapter 1266 of the Public Laws, 1943, for the preservation of the Classical High School property damaged by fire, said act having been approved February 8, 1943. Said bonds shall be designated "Emergency Bonds", and may be in any denomination not exceeding Twenty Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars each, the principal thereof and the interest thereon shall be payable in any coin or currency of the United States which at the time of payment is legal tender for public and private debts, and the debts incurred by said bonds shall be obligatory on said City in the same manner and to the same extent as other debts lawfully contracted by said City. The dates of maturity of said bonds shall in no case be more than three (3) years after date of issue.

Sec. 2. The City Treasurer, with the advice and consent of the Committee on Finance, and subject to the approval of the Mayor, shall sell and dispose of such bonds at not less than par and accrued interest, if any, and issue said bonds, or cause them to be issued under the corporate name and seal of the City of Providence, and when issued, shall receive the proceeds from such sale, and the full amount of said proceeds shall be applied pursuant to the provisions of said Chapter 1266 of the Public Laws, as passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A. D. 1943, for the preservation and repair of the Classical High School property.


Sec. 3. Said bonds shall be signed by the City Treasurer and countersigned by the Mayor of the City of Providence and registered by the City Controller and shall be issued and sold at such times and in such amounts as the City Council of said City shall determine; provided, however, that the premiums, if any, arising from the sale of said bonds shall be applied to the payment of the principal of said bonds in the order of their maturity.

Sec. 4. All bidders for said bonds shall be required to name the rate of interest that said bonds shall bear. Such rate of interest, when bid, shall apply to the entire issue of said bonds. Said interest shall be payable on the first days of January and July in each year.

Sec. 5. Said bonds shall be payable as provided in said Chapter 1266, of the Public Laws, 1943, and both principal and interest shall be payable in any coin or currency of the United States of America, which at the time of payment is legal tender for public and private debts, at the fiscal agency of the City of Providence, in New York City. The holders of coupon bonds may at any time exchange the same for registered bonds payable at the office of the City Treasurer.

Sec. 6. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Treasurer to use forms of bonds substantially the same as the forms approved by the City Council by Resolution 616, approved September 5, 1947





Sec. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.



Approved May 26, 1958

Whereas, on May 6, 1958 a fire caused serious damage to the property known as Classical High School and an emergency measure is necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of that property, and

WHEREAS the City Council desires to take action for the preservation of that property, the City Council hereby declares that an emergency situation exists, and

WHEREAS the City Council has this day enacted an emergency ordinance providing for the issuance of bonds in the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$150,000.00) DOLLARS for the repair of said Classical High School under the emergency provisions of Sections 25-27 and 135 of the Charter of the City of Providence as amended by Chapter 1266 of the Public Laws of 1943 with respect to bonds issued in case of fire, flood, hurricane or other calamity, and acting under the provisions of Chapter 1017 of the Public Laws of 1902, with respect to the issuance of notes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Treasurer acting under the Committee on Finance, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to borrow from time to time and in such amounts as may be approved by the Committee on Finance, a sum not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$150,000.00) Dollars, and to issue and sell at private sale, the City's negotiable notes, original and in renewal thereof, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding two and one-half (2½%) percentum per annum, said original notes and any renewal notes therefor to be signed by the City Treasurer and countersigned by the Mayor and the Chairman of the Committee on Finance; said original notes to mature not exceeding six (6) months from the date of issuance, and the same may be renewed from time to time for further periods of six (6) months, but said notes shall mature in any event within three (3) years from the date of the first issuance; the money thus obtained to be bonded under the provisions of Chapter 1266 of the Public Laws, 1943,

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Providence has this twenty-sixth day of May, A. D. 1958 enacted an Emergency Ordinance providing for the issuance of bonds in the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$150,000.00) Dollars for the preservation and repair of the Classical High School property, and

WHEREAS by City Council Resolution No. 293 approved May 26, 1958 the City Council has authorized the City Treasurer to issue and sell the City's negotiable notes in the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$150,000.00) Dollars for said purposes

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$150,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated for the preservation and repair of the Classical High School property damaged by the fire of May 6, 1958. Said money shall be expended for the specific purpose named in said Resolution No. 293 and a separate account entitled "Classical High School Fire Damage Account" shall be set up, against which the charges incidental thereto shall be made and accounted for.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Dear Mr. Aiello,

It is my personal belief that the student body, faculty, and parents of the students of Classical High School desire that there be no interruption in the educational training and morale of our outstanding school. To that end it is necessary that we continue the business of education in our present high school site. Interruption of our specialized system of Classical High School training for six months might mean the termination of the school.

The faculty of Classical High School in a special meeting called by the principal on Friday, May 23, 1958 voted to commend the Providence School Committee and administration for their swift action in voting to restore the school building to classroom use by September 3, 1958.

The faculty by a sealed vote of 40 to 3 authorized the principal to commend the Providence School Committee for its action and to petition the Providence City Council to grant the emergency appropriation of \$150,000 to repair the building and to restore it to immediate use for classroom purposes, that Classical High School may continue its valued functions.
