


RESOLVED, That the Mayor's Office of Community Development is hereby requested to allocate Sixty-Four Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$64,175.00) for historic renovations and rehabilitation for the Rhodes Street Historic District. This allocation (as itemized during the M.O.C.D. Public Hearing, April 13) should come from the M.O.C.D. Block Grant Budget (\$7,428,000.00) or the additional funds provided by the Jobs Bill (approximately \$2,500,000.00). As listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Rhodes Street Historic District consists of 19 early and late Victorian houses on one block of Rhodes Street and adjacent Alphonso and Janes Streets.
