No. 516 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 1051 by ADDING the SUM of TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000) DOLLARS to the APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN for GENERAL PUBLIC ASSISTANCE, ITEMS 1 and 3.

Approved September 6, 1957

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 1051 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1956, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$33,514,967.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1957", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for General Public Assistance, Items 1 and 3. Said sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be apportioned as follows: Item 1 - \$9,000; Item 3 - \$16,000.

SECTION 2: The sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000) Dollars as herein appropriated shall be obtained by increasing the estimated receipts as follows:

Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures	\$ 7,500
Grants-in-Aid (State of Rhode Island)	
General Public Assistance	17,500

SECTION 3: The City Controller and City Treasurer are hereby authorized to transfer the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500) Dollars from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 4: The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500) Dollars.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

No. 517 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING CHAPTER 1044 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED JULY 12, 1956, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR WEST RIVER PROJECT NO. UR R.I. 1-6"

Approved September 6, 1957

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

1. That Chapter 1044 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence entitled "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for West River Project No. UR R.I. 1-6" approved July 12, 1956 be and is hereby further amended by adding to Paragraph 10, page 8 and inserting the following subparagraph after subparagraph (b):

(c) That Section 4 i(5) on page 15 of the Redevelopment Plan be deleted and in lieu thereof the following is inserted and made a part thereof:

"The construction of buildings shall conform to the regulations set forth in Chapter 1079, 1956, known as the 'Building Ordinance of the City of Providence' adopted December 21, 1956, as amended, and all future amendments thereto."

2. That said ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed in every other respect.

3. This ordinance shall take effect on its passage and shall be filed with the City Clerk who is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

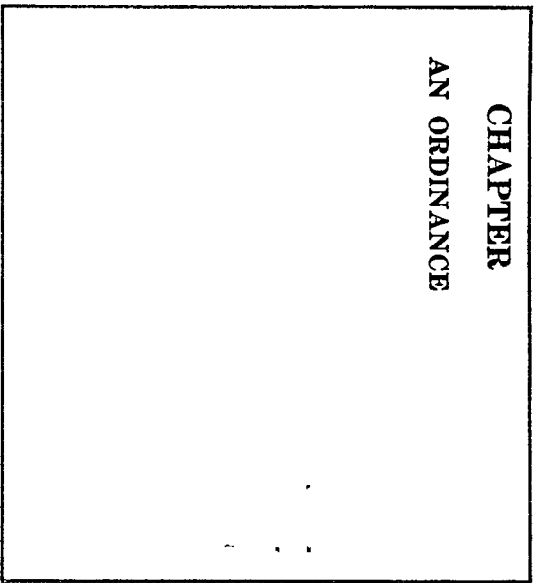

Gentlemen:

By Chapter 1044 of the Ordinances adopted on July 12, 1956, your Honorable Body adopted the official Redevelopment Plan for the West River Project No. UR R.I. 1-6. Section 4 i(5) at page 15 of the Plan as adopted provides that the construction of all buildings shall conform to the regulations set forth in the building code adopted in January 1923, as amended to the date of the approval of the Plan.

By Chapter 1079 of the Ordinances adopted on December 21, 1956 your Honorable Body passed the "Building Ordinance of the City of Providence" which said ordinance has been subsequently amended.

After review of the "Building Ordinance of the City of Providence", as amended, the Providence Redevelopment Agency desires to suggest an amendment to Chapter 1044 of the Ordinances. This Agency recommends that Paragraph 4 i(5) on page 15 of the Plan, as approved, be deleted and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

"(5) The construction of buildings shall conform to the regulations set forth in the 'Building Ordinance of the City of Providence', adopted December 21, 1956, as amended, and all future amendments thereto."

A certified copy of Resolution No. 355 of the Providence Redevelopment Agency approved June 13, 1957 is attached hereto. This report is made pursuant to the aforementioned resolution.

Resolved,

That in accordance with the provisions of Section 28 of Chapter 1665 of the Public Laws of 1945, approved April 27, 1945, the City Controller is hereby authorized and directed to establish in the accounts for the year ending September 30, 1958, a specific purpose account to be known as "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the Year 1957-1958". Said account shall be established by charging to the account entitled "Current Year Surplus" of the accounts of 1956-1957, an amount equal to any credit balance existing in said Current Year Surplus Account at the close of the fiscal year. After completion of the above transfer, the account entitled "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the year 1957-1958" shall be carried over to the books of account for the year 1957-1958 with an open credit balance equal to the amount of the transfer.

From time to time during the year ending September 30, 1958, the City Council, when necessary, may direct the City Controller and the City Treasurer to pay out of General Fund cash the total or any part of the then credit balance existing in the account entitled "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the year 1957-1958", each such payment shall be charged to said account and shall immediately be paid over to the City Collector as a receipt account, and when so received by him, shall be credited to a receipt account to be entitled "Receipts for Extraordinary Expenditures of the Year 1957-1958". The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to pay out of General Fund Cash, the total of any balance remaining in the "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the year 1956-1957" and such payment shall be charged to said account and paid over to the City Collector as a receipt to "Receipts for Extraordinary Expenditures of the Year 1956-1957".
