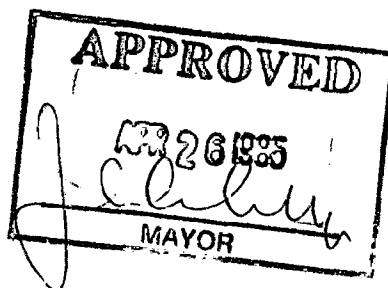

RELATING TO ALTERNATES OF THE  
MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general law or special act, the Mayor of Providence is hereby authorized to appoint a designee to represent him on any commission, board, or agency which by law requires the membership and/or attendance of the Mayor of the City of Providence. Such designee of the Mayor shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor of the City of Providence. The appointment and/or removal of the designee shall become effective upon written notification by the Mayor to the Clerk of the City of Providence and to the President of the City Council.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
