

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 375

Approved November 13, 2020

WHEREAS, Ruth Bader Ginsburg, born Joan Ruth Bader on March 15, 1933 in Brooklyn, New York, was one of the most revered, influential and notable Justices to have served on the Supreme Court of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Ruth Bader Ginsburg, spent a lifetime overcoming adversity before being appointed a Supreme Court justice; and

WHEREAS, Ruth Bader Ginsburg, was the second woman to serve on the Supreme Court and broke barriers throughout her 27-year service on the nation's highest court; and

WHEREAS, Ruth Bader Ginsburg was a legal, cultural and feminist icon and a Justice with enormous historic stature; and

WHEREAS, Ruth Bader Ginsburg was fueled by a thirst for justice and spent her career as an acclaimed attorney, brilliant scholar, and trailblazing jurist; and

WHEREAS, Ruth Bader Ginsburg's legacy as a champion for women's rights, gender justice, abortion rights, voting rights, the rights of immigrants, and the rights of LGBTQ individuals will have a lasting impact on the cultural and legal fabric of the United States of America.


