




The following resolutions have been received from your Committee and this department has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is hereby requested to post restricted parking signs along the area in the rear of the Washington Park Center.

Disposition: The parking area in question is private parking and we have no authority to post signs other than on the public right-of-way.

Request: That the Traffic Engineer cause for the installation of a four-way stop control at the intersection of Updike Street and Princeton Avenue.
