

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 441

Approved May 9, 1979

WHEREAS, in a recent article of the Providence Journal-Evening Bulletin the deplorable conditions that exist in the Roger Williams Housing Project were depicted such as broken doors, windows and pipes; as well as infestation of rubbish, insects and rodents, and

WHEREAS, because of the deplorable conditions that exist in said project the City Code Enforcement Division was forced to declare said project unfit for human habitation, and

WHEREAS, said project is being financed and operated with the City of Providence's taxpayers dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Committee on Public Welfare is hereby requested to cause to be conducted an investigation into management and operation of the Roger Williams Housing Project to determine the reason or reasons for allowing such deplorable unsafe and unhealthy conditions to exist.
