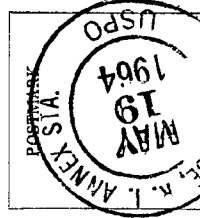

AMENDATORY GRANT OFFER

This Amendatory Grant Offer by and between City of Providence (herein called the "Applicant") and the Housing and Home Finance Agency, hereinafter referred to as the Government, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grant Offer, dated October 24, 1963, and the Acceptance dated November 8, 1963, between the parties hereto, provided that, subject to the terms and conditions thereof, that the Government would make a grant of not to exceed \$143,000 in order to aid in financing the construction of essential public works or facilities estimated to cost \$345,000; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the public works and facilities has increased from \$345,000 to \$452,000; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant and the Government are desirous of amending the Grant Agreement as hereinafter set forth;


NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual benefits flowing to the Applicant and the Government, the aforesaid Grant Offer is hereby amended as follows:

1. In line 8, change "\$345,000" to "\$452,000".
2. In line 12, change "\$286,000" to "\$452,000".

All the provisions, terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement shall remain in full force except as amended hereby.





