

Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 12 of Chapter 1375, as amended, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved December 2, 1960; and Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports concerning the proposed sale of real property within the Huntington Expressway Industrial Park.

The Agency proposes to sell a certain parcel of land situated within the Huntington Expressway Industrial Park to Vargas Manufacturing Company, or its assignees. Said parcel of land is comprised of approximately 5.3 acres and will be sold for a total sales price of \$57,271.75.

Vargas Manufacturing Company is a local concern which specializes in the manufacture of rings and jewelry. Present employment is approximately 200 and is expected to increase to 225 at the new plant, with a further increase to 280 within the next few years. Site plans submitted by the Redeveloper indicate they will construct a 31,500 sq. ft. building with provisions for future expansion. The cost of the initial building is estimated at \$375,000.

The sale of land to Vargas Manufacturing Company will permit them to modernize and consolidate their manufacturing operations and will result in an increase in employment and the tax base of the City of Providence.

Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 12 of Chapter 1375, as amended, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved December 2, 1960; and Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports concerning the proposed sale of real property within the Huntington Expressway Industrial Park

D & A Electroplating Company proposes to purchase a certain parcel of land situated within the Huntington Expressway Industrial Park. Said parcel of land contains 45,673 square feet and will be sold for a total sales price of \$27,403.80.

The Redeveloper is a local concern engaged in the electroplating of costume jewelry, industrial plating and plating of electronic circuit boards. Present employment is approximately 25 and is expected to increase to 50 at the new plant. Preliminary site plans submitted by D & A Electroplating Company indicate that the developer intends to construct a 10,000 square foot building with provisions for expansion to 15,000 square feet in the future. The cost of the new construction is estimated in excess of \$100,000.

The sale of land to D & A Electroplating Company will permit the retention of one of our smaller industries who wish to expand and yet remain in the City of Providence and will also increase the tax base of the City.



Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 11 of Chapter 1575 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved October 18, 1963, and Title 45, Chapters 31-33 (inclusive) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports concerning the proposed sale of real property within the Weybosset Hill Project No. R.I. R-7.

The Agency proposes to sell a certain parcel of land situated within the Weybosset Hill Project No. R.I. R-7 to the Weybosset Hill Development Corporation and Downtown Realty Inc, more commonly known as the Joint-Venture of Reynolds-Gilbane. Said parcel of land is bounded by Empire and Westminster Streets and the proposed extension of Greene Street and is delineated on the attached map. Parcel 15A contains 47,131 square feet and will be sold for a total sales price of \$212,089.50.

Preliminary plans submitted by the redeveloper indicate that Parcel 15A will be the site of the Blue Cross office building. The Hospital Service Corporation will consolidate and modernize their operations within the four floors of the new building, which will provide them with approximately 83,000 square feet of floor space. Estimated cost of construction is in excess of \$1,500,000.

The redeveloper's architects and the Agency staff have coordinated their efforts to design a structure which will harmonize structurally and aesthetically with existing and proposed buildings in the Weybosset Hill Project and the proposed extension of the Westminster Street pedestrian mall.


