
WHEREAS, 187 Westminster Street Associates is under new ownership and is being renovated and restored to its original appearance, and

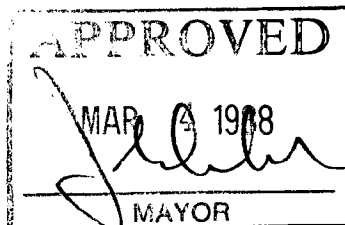



Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

The 187 Westminster Building (former Woolworth Building and Dorrance Hotel) is under new ownership and is being renovated and restored to its original external appearance. During this process, the building's main entrance will be moved from Westminster Mall to Dorrance Street, and two new ground-floor stores, either side of the new entrance, will replace the former Old Stone Bank branch.

It is our understanding that this block of Dorrance Street, on that side of the street, is eligible for odd numbers from 31 to 59. If that is correct, the owners, 187 Westminster Associates, wish to apply for 55 Dorrance Street for the new building entrance and 45 and 57 for the two proposed store areas. All three of these numbers were formerly listed under 185 Westminster Street when the area was occupied by the Old Stone Bank and the entrance was on Westminster Mall.
