PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

1. The undersigned respectfully petitions to abandon as public highways that portion of Peck Street between Friendship Street and Dyer Street and that portion of Orange Street from Friendship Street and Clifford Street.
2. Petitioner is the owner of three parcels of land abutting both sides of the aforesaid portions of Peck and Orange Streets.
3. Due to the recent construction of the J. Joseph Garrahy Judicial Complex and its impact upon traffic patterns in downtown Providence, petitioner has been advised by the United States Government Department of Transportation, the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, the Providence Foundation and the City of Providence Department of Planning and Development that considerable alterations to and realignment of existing street layouts are being planned and will be made in the near future. As a result thereof the aforesaid portions of Peck Street and Orange Street are and will become no longer useful as public highways.
4. This petitioner has been requested by the United States Department of Transportation, the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, Providence Foundation and the City of Providence, Department of Planning and Development to assist in the implementation of these plans by allowing certain portions of its aforesaid parcels of land to be used for the rerouting of traffic in the downtown area. It has also been requested to file this petition for the abandonment of the aforesaid portions of Peck and Orange Streets so that the proposed traffic patterns may be effective. Furthermore, it is the intention of the petitioner to use the abandoned portions of Peck Street and Orange Street to provide additional downtown off-street parking spaces.
5. Wherefore, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 24-6 of the General Laws of Rhode Island 1956 (1969 Reenactment as amended), the petitioner Amica Mutual Insurance Company respectfully requests abandonment of the aforesaid portions of Peck Street and Orange Street, more specifically

described and laid out on the plans attached hereto and marked Exhibits "A" and "B".

Said streets are also set forth on the "Location Plan" attached hereto and marked Exhibit "C".

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission, at its June 9, 1982 rescheduled monthly meeting, reviewed and evaluated the subject referral which contained a request by Amica Mutual Insurance Company for the abandonments of that portion of Peck Street from Friendship Street to Dyer Street and that portion of Orange Street from Friendship Street to Clifford Street.

A field inspection revealed that portion of Peck Street is a 52 ft. wide improved public right-of-way with sidewalks and curbs. It abuts a parking lot at each side. That portion of Orange Street in question is a 40 ft. wide improved public right-of-way with sidewalks and curbs. It also abuts a parking lot at each side. These three parking lots are asphalt paved, well maintained and are owned by the petitioner to serve its employees and business. There are parking lots and commercial buildings within the surrounding area. The subject portions are located within the M-1 General Industrial Zone which abuts the C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone at Friendship Street.

The Commission determined that there is no demonstrated need to serve public interest with this abandonment. Therefore,

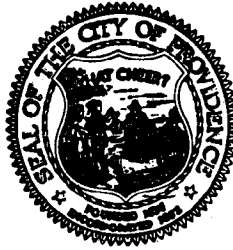



Gentlemen:

This letter is transmitted in compliance with your earlier memorandum requesting this department's review and report on the above referred to proposed abandonments.

Staff of this department undertook a field inspection of the area, which revealed that the portion of Peck Street that is proposed for abandonment is a fifty-two (52') foot wide improved right-of-way with sidewalks and curbs and abuts a parking lot at each side; that the portion of Orange Street, proposed for abandonment is a forty (40') foot wide improved right-of-way with sidewalks and curbs and abuts a parking lot at each side; and that the three (3) parking lots are asphalt paved, well maintained, and are owned by the petitioner and serve its employees and business. There are parking lots and commercial buildings within the surrounding area. The areas proposed for abandonment are located within the M-1 General Industrial Zone, which abuts the C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone at Friendship Street.

The City Plan Commission in its June 15, 1982 letter to your Committee determined that there was no demonstrated need that the abandonments would serve the public's interest and they recommended that the petition be denied. However, since that action I have conversed with the attorney for the petitioner and was able to ascertain that the abandoned street areas would be integrated with the three (3) parking areas and would result in a twenty-five (25%) percent increase in off street parking.

The proposed abandonments will facilitate an increase in off street parking to serve the downtown area; will accommodate the downtown ring road, which it borders; and will be in compliance with the City's interim Master Plan for Downtown Providence.


