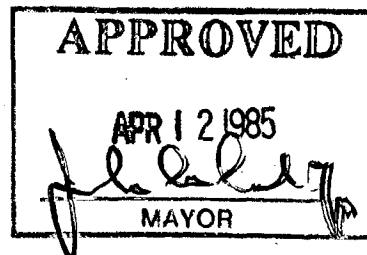

RELATING TO STATEWIDE WATER SUPPLY
SYSTEM

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established a nine (9) member com-
2 mission for the purpose of making recommendations to the governor and
3 the general assembly for the establishment and creation of a single
4 statewide water supply system. Such commission shall review and make
5 recommendations regarding the relationship between the state water
6 supply board and the Providence water supply system and other related
7 matters.

8 The mayor of the city of Providence shall appoint five (5) mem-
9 bers to such commission. The speaker of the house shall designate two
10 (2) members and the majority leader of the senate and the governor
11 shall designate one (1) member each. The commission shall make its
12 report to the governor and the general assembly on or before March 1,
13 1986. On or before the first Tuesday in August the commission shall
14 organize and from among its members select a chairperson and secre-
15 tary.

1 SECTION 2. The Providence water supply board and the state water
2 resource board shall make its staff and records available to the com-
3 mission.

4 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated twenty thousand
5 (\$20,000) dollars for consultant and clerical and administrative costs
6 relating to the commission.

7 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
