WHEREAS, Said Act establishes a nine-member Commission for the purpose of making recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly for the establishment and creation of a single Statewide Water Supply System, and

WHEREAS, the Commission shall review and make recommendations regarding the relationship between the State and Providence Water Supply System and other related matters,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the Providence City Council hereby endorse and urge passage of Senate Bill 85-S 724, presently pending before the Senate Corporations Committee, and



2 resource board shall make its staff and records available to the com-  
3 mission.

4           SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated twenty thousand

7           SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
