Gentlemen:

I find difficulty in locating very many areas in the Central Business District that do not have unrestricted parking between 6PM and 2AM. All metered parking spaces are unrestricted during this time and most other restrictions are in affect until 6PM. There are only a few main arteries where we have NO PARKING ANY TIME restrictions; I feel that with evening shopping two nights a week, these restrictions are warranted and should not be changed. Therefore, I would say that unrestricted parking per your request is presently permitted on 90% of the streets within the Central Business District.

I therefore see no need for any change at this time.
