

Dear Sir:

In compliance with the resolution requesting the Commissioner of Public Safety to cause a study and report to the City Council as to the feasibility of the installation of red illuminations denoting the existence of outside fire alarm boxes, the following information was submitted by the Chief of the Fire Department:

The installation of illumination denoting the location of outside Fire Alarm Boxes, that would delete any possibility of any delay in sounding an alarm for fire, would be welcomed by the Providence Fire Department, particularly if it would be a deterrent to the sounding of false alarms.

From the last survey of this city by the National Board of Fire Underwriters' engineers, it was recommended that distinguishing colored lights be installed over boxes in all closely built sections to indicate their locations at night




