RESOLVED, That the City Solicitor shall prepare, cause to be introduced and urge passage at the 1982 Session of the General Assembly of an Act Relating to Amusement Centers within the City of Providence, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said act shall have the effect of

1. changing the definition of Amusement Centers to any place having Two (2) or more mechanical amusement devices;
2. prohibiting the issuance of a license for an Amusement Center or a mechanical amusement device on any premises, any point of which is within 1,200 feet of any point on the property of any school, public or private, except in an establishment having a B, C, D, or J Liquor License issued by the Bureau of Licenses.
