ELECTION OF CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE PROVIDENCE MUNICIPAL COURT.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for nominations for Chief Justice of the Providence Municipal Court and COUNCILMAN TURCHETTA nominates EDWARD F. MALLOY, ESQUIRE, of Providence; this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMEN ADDISON, AHERN, CIRELLI, COLA, CROWLEY, FARGNOLI, FLYNN, LYNCH and MEROLA.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for further nominations and there are none.

There being no further nominations, on motion of COUNCILMAN LYNCH, seconded by COUNCILMAN ADDISON, it is voted that nominations be closed and the Clerk be directed to cast one ballot for Mr. Malloy as Chief Justice of the Providence Municipal Court.

The Clerk casts one ballot for Mr. Malloy, as directed.
