WHEREAS, Right Reverend Monsignor Anthony L. Dimeo, Pastor of Saint Ann's Roman Catholic Church in Providence, was honored by a Testimonial Dinner in celebration of the Fortieth Anniversary of his Ordination to the Priesthood on May 27, 1973, and
