STANDARD HOURS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

SECTION 1. Section 162.2 of Article XV of Chapter 2 of
the 1946 Revised Ordinances now entitled "Standard Hours" is here-
by amended to read as follows: "STANDARD HOURS and STANDARD WORK
WEEK".

Sec. 162.2 Same - Standard Hours and Standard Work Week

The standard hours of employment in any one work week
for all permanent employees of the City of Providence,
except watchmen and school department employees, whose
pay is established on an hourly basis in the city comp-
ensation plan shall be forty hours. The standard work
week of employment in any one work week for all perman-
ent employees of the City of Providence whose pay is
established on a daily basis in the city compensation
plan shall be five days and the five day work week may
be any five days of the seven day week as may be de-
termined by the heads of the individual departments.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and become
operative as of October 1, 1960.

of the 1946 REVISED ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION"
OVERTIME PAY.

APPROVED: September 16, 1960

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

SECTION 1. Section 162.4 of Article XV of Chapter 2 of
the Revised Ordinances, entitled "Administration", is hereby amend-
ed to read as follows:

Sec. 162.4 Same - Overtime Pay

Any permanent employee of the City,
except school department employees and watchmen
whose pay is established on an hourly basis in
the city compensation plan shall be entitled
to and shall be paid overtime pay at the rate
of 150% of the rate of payment established in
the city compensation plan for the particular
position which he holds, for each full hour
or part of hour of employment in excess of the
standard hours of employment rendered in any
one work week.

Any permanent employee of the city whose
pay is established on a daily basis in the city
compensation plan shall be entitled to and shall
be paid overtime pay at the rate of 150% of the
rate of payment established in the city compensa-
tion plan for the particular position which he
holds, for each full day or part of day in ex-
cess of the standard days of employment rendered
in any one work week.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and become
operative October 1, 1960.

NO: 424 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 43.1 and 43.2 of
CHAPTER 2 of the 1946 REVISED ORDINANCES, ENTITLED
"ADMINISTRATION".

APPROVED: September 16, 1960

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

SECTION 1. The last paragraph of Section 43.1 of Article III of Chapter 2 of the 1946 Revised Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows: Subsequent to his first full year of service, each fireman shall be entitled to receive forty-five dollars each year; provided, however, that each fireman regularly required to wear dress uniform during his hours of duty shall be entitled to receive seventy-five dollars each year. Said sums shall be paid at such times and upon such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by rule or regulation adopted by Commissioner of Public Safety and approved by the City Controller.

SECTION 2. The last paragraph of Section 43.2 of Article III of Chapter 2 of the 1946 Revised Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows: Subsequent to his first full year of service each uniformed police officer, detective and police driver shall be entitled to receive seventy-five dollars each year to be paid at such times and upon such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by rule or regulation to be adopted by Commissioner of Public Safety with the approval of the City Controller.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and become operative as of October 1, 1960.

of the 1946 Revised Ordinances, entitled "Administration" is
hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 165.2 - Holiday Pay for Policemen & Firemen

Policemen and Firemen, whether on duty or not,
shall be entitled to and shall receive one extra
day's pay for the following holidays; said pay
to be computed on a basis of one-fifth of a full
week's pay, viz:

New Year's Day
Independence Day
Labor Day
Columbus Day
Armistice Day
Thanksgiving Day
and
Christmas Day

No. 426 **AN ORDINANCE** REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 1960, A REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF BONDS FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT REVOLVING FUND IN THE SUM OF ELEVEN MILLION (\$11,000,000) DOLLARS

Approved September 16, 1960

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The Secretary of State is hereby requested to submit the following question to the qualified electors of the City of Providence at the General Election to be held in the City of Providence, Tuesday, November 8, 1960, viz:


"Shall the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding Eleven Million (\$11,000,000) Dollars for the Redevelopment Revolving Fund authorized by Title 45, Chapter 33, Section 1 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956; and shall the proceeds of the sale of said issue of bonds be used to effectuate any or all of the purposes and provisions of the "Redevelopment act of 1956" and amendments thereto?"

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit to the Secretary of State forthwith upon the passage of this Ordinance a certified copy thereof.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, and all Ordinances and Resolutions and parts of either, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. 427 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 1288, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF NINE THOUSAND (\$9,000) DOLLARS TO PUBLIC WORKS-MUNICIPAL DOCKS SECTION, ITEM 1.

Approved September 16, 1960

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1288 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1959 entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$39,301,585.32 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1960", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000) Dollars to PUBLIC WORKS-MUNICIPAL DOCKS SECTION, ITEM 1.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by increasing the estimated receipts from Property Taxes-Previous Year by the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000) Dollars.

SECTION 3. The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized to transfer this appropriation from the General Fund to an account in the Trust and Special Funds to be known as "MUNICIPAL DOCKS PROMOTION ACCOUNT".

SECTION 4. This Ordinances shall take effect upon its passage.
